Renate's Tip's

I am going to give you a few tips now which I hope will help you when you are doing your own home renovating.

When I paint I often have breaks because I like to enjoy what I am doing & take my time. This can lead to problems with paint drying on your roller or paint brush. If this happens they leave scratch marks on the wall because either the paint dries or the bristle go stiff so they have to be thrown out.

I used to use the old plastic shopping bags and put the roller or bristle brushes in there and wrap them up tight but you can also use glad wrap. Just wrap it around the roller or bristles and often if you don't come back till the next day the brush is still good to go.

Same with your painting tray put it inside a plastic bag or just put cling wrap across the top to keep the air out and stop the paint from skinning over.

I do the tray and the roller or brushes separately. I don't wrap them up together with the paint brush or roller still in the tray. Maybe you could do that but I haven't tried it.

Take the time to enjoy yourself if you are giving your home a face life. You can put nice music on or I always have the television playing in the background with a DVD I really like especially if I am alone and it makes me feel like I have company.

I also take the time to have nice snacks available. Just in case I get peckish.
